Current (Article VI, Board of Directors, Section 2. Associate Directors)

Associate Directors: There shall be up to four (4) associate directors who shall be appointed by the executive committee for a term of two (2) years. Associate members will consist of two (2) associate members, one (1) representative of the broadcast engineering field and one (1) non-commercial broadcaster. These associate directors shall not have voting rights at meetings of the Board of Directors, shall not be counted for purposes of a quorum, and shall not be eligible to serve as an officer of the Association.

### Suggested Revision:

Associate Directors: There shall be up to four (4) associate directors appointed by the executive committee. Associate members will consist of two (2) associate members serving a term of two (2) years, one (1) representative of the broadcast engineering field filled by the current president of the SBE, and one (1) non-commercial broadcaster serving a term of two (2) years. These associate directors shall not have voting rights at meetings of the Board of Directors, shall not be counted for purposes of a quorum, and shall not be eligible to serve as an officer of the Association.
